

# Master of Management (Finance)

## Recommended Study Plan – MC-MGMTFIN (12 subject program - 150 points)

The Master of Management (Finance) 12 subject program consists of 1 constrained-choice foundation subject to be completed in the first semester, 3 discipline core subjects, 4 finance elective subjects, 3 general electives and 1 capstone subject to be taken in the final semester of study.

**\*ADDITIONAL SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS:** Students in the 150 point program who have not completed prior studies equivalent to any (one) of the following foundation subjects are required to complete that subject in their first semester of study: ACCT90004 Accounting for Decision Making, ECOM90009 Quantitative Methods for Business or ECON90005 Managerial Economics. The required subject will be credited towards your program as a general elective. **If you are required to take one of these subjects, it will be noted in your letter of offer for the program. If your letter of offer does not list a required subject, you should follow the recommended study plan for your first semester.**
