

# Master of Management (Accounting)

## Recommended Study Plan - MC-MGMTACT (12 subject program - 150 points)

The Master of Management (Accounting) 12 subject program consists of 1 foundation subject to be completed in the first semester of study, 8 discipline core subjects, 2 general electives chosen from the Master of Management list of electives, and 1 capstone subject to be completed in the final semester of study.

\*Students who have not completed either ACCT90004 Accounting for Decision Making (ADM) (or equivalent), or FNCE90060 Financial Management (or equivalent) in their undergraduate degree, are required to take these subjects in their first semester of study in place of their general electives. If you are required to take ADM and/or Financial Management, this will be mentioned in your letter of offer for the program. If your letter of offer does not advise that you are required to take either of these subjects, then it is not necessary for you to complete these subjects.

<b>Discipline Core</b>	<u>ACCT90012</u>	Corporate Reporting <i>(Pre-requisite: ACCT90004 Accounting for Decision Making)</i>  <i>*(Students who are required to take ACCT90004 Accounting for Decision Making (ADM) will need to substitute ACCT90012 Corporate Reporting with ADM in their first semester and take Corporate Reporting in their second semester)</i>

<b>Capstone Subject</b>	<u>ACCT90033</u>	Integrated Accounting Studies (Pre-requisites: ACCT90009 Strategic Cost Management and ACCT90012 Corporate Reporting)  (The capstone subject must be completed in the final semester of study)
