

Graduate Diploma in Economics

Recommended Study Plan - GD-ECO (8 subject program - 100 points)

The Diploma consists of 8 semester-length subjects comprising 2 core economics subjects, 1 quantitative subject and 5 elective subjects.



This program has only one intake per year

Students who successfully complete the Graduate Diploma in Economics may be eligible to progress to Year Two of the Master of Economics.
