

# Master of Finance

## Recommended Study Plan – MC-FIN (16 subject program - 200 points)

The degree is designed to be completed in two years of full-time study and requires completion of 200 points. The first year has 6 discipline core subjects of 12.5 points each and 2 elective subjects of 12.5 points each. The second year of the program comprises 4 discipline core subjects of 12.5 points each and elective subjects worth 50 points in total.
